RULES: MNZ General Road Racing plus the following Supplementary Regulations

1. Additional entries and Class extensions on the day will be at the Organisers Discretion.
2. Oil leakage. Machine to be removed for repair. Second occurrence may mean exclusion.
3. Machine examination 'pass' sticker must be attached in a visible position.
4. Use of Ethylene Glycol is not permitted.
5. Minimum entries per class to be at Organisers discretion.
6. Maximum entries per class is 40.
7. Any bike involved in a crash incident must be re-examined by Scrutineer and rider to receive a clearance from the circuit Doctor prior to competing in their next race.
8. Race practice will be run in organised classes but may change at Organisers discretion. (All practice sessions will be timed and used as qualifying).
9. Any offensive advertising wording on bikes, fairings, pit crew clothing etc must be taped over or removed.
10. The organisers invite application from entrants who wish to erect any advertising and/or mount any promotional activity at this meeting venue. Such advertising and/or promotional activity shall not be undertaken without obtaining permission to do so from the Organisers in conjunction with the major sponsor for this event.
11. A 600cc bike is eligible for either Formula 1 or 600 Supersport.
12. Super Motard machines are only eligible for S1 and S2 Super Motard Races.
13. Sidecars, if entries in this class exceed safe running numbers, sidecars need to set a qualifying time in practice.
