Supplementary Regulations

- Starts will drop of the flag and lights.
- Grid position will be by random peg draw.
- Organizers in conjunction with the Steward of the Meeting reserve the right to change the racing format on the day as the situation may dictate.

- All championship classes must have six entries by closing date to be recognized by MNZ.
- As per rule 10-1 technical inspection of bikes can be carried out.
- As per rule 10-2-2 All riders must have race numbers centrally located on the front and rear of their bikes and be 150mm regulation size and clear to read.
- Competitors must have their bike number clearly visible on their backs. .
- Refunds are available on request in writing, as per rule 5-6-2.
- No dogs allowed.

- **ALL QUADS MUST BE UNDER 96 DECIBELS.** Noise testing and safety inspections will be carried out will be carried out.
